Dear Parent/Carer

Year 5 will be going on a visit to Jorvik and 'The Dig' in York as part of our history topic about the Vikings. We will be looking at the Anglo-Saxon/Viking settlements and way of life in Britain.

The children will have a chance to experience the sights and sounds of Viking York at the Jorvik Museum as well as taking part in a workshop at The Dig.

The visit will be on **Wednesday 31 January 2024** and will cost **£19.00**, which includes entrance to Jorvik, the workshops at 'The Dig' and the cost of transport. We rely on voluntary contributions for our visits, and it is hoped that all parents will be supportive of the school's efforts to organise the venture.

If we do not receive enough voluntary contributions, the visit may not be able to go ahead.

We will **be leaving school at 9.00am**, therefore the children need to be at school for **normal time**. We will return at approximately **3:30pm**. All children will require a packed lunch (no glass bottles please. If your child is entitled to free school meals, they can have a packed lunch provided by school, please use the following link to book their sandwich preference <https://forms.office.com/e/1iRactx3qt>. All students are welcome to **dress up as Vikings**. We will add some images to DoJo for an idea of what your child could wear. If they do not want to dress up, please can your child come in their normal school uniform. If your child requires a travel sickness tablet, please make sure they have one before they come to school. Any medication required for the trip must be handed in the day before and a medical form completed at the office.

They will also need to wear sensible footwear and will need a coat as the classes will have to walk through York. If the time and weather allow, we may be able to walk up to see the Minster and down through the Shambles to give the children a taste of the city.

If your child uses an inhaler, please make sure they have one at school with the labelled box and medical form completed.

Permission and payment can be made through ParentPay.

The information which you provide on ParentPay will be taken on the visit and used in case of an emergency.
