Chicken noodles ingredients

Wheat Flour, Palm Oil, Maltodextrin, Iodised Salt [Salt, Potassium Iodate], Sugar, Onion Powder, Yeast Extract, Flavouring, Turmeric, Garlic Powder, Stabiliser (Guar Gum), Acidity Regulator (Citric Acid), Dried Parsley, Turmeric Extract, Sage Powder, Colour (Riboflavins)

Prawn crackers ingredients

Tapioca Starch, Vegetable Oils in varying proportions [Rapeseed, Sunflower], Prawns (Crustacean) (18%), Sugar, Salt

This will help us to gather information about your child's allergies or dietary restrictions. Please fill out the form carefully, indicate any specific food or ingredients your child must avoid. **You must complete the form to ensure that your child is able to participate.**

If your child has severe allergies that require an EpiPen or any other specific precautions, please provide those details on the form. Rest assured that we will take all necessary precautions to prevent cross-contamination and ensure a safe environment.
