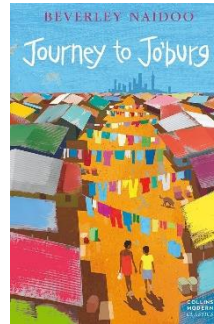


CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER

Trade

Our Learning Journey this half term is based around the Trade and how this impacts the world around us.
