Murton Park

On **3 July 2024**, students in Year 4 will be visiting Murton Park. As part of our theme in History 'The Romans' Year 4 will take part in a workshop delivered by experienced and qualified staff who are all subject specialists. They will spend their day in a 1st century Roman fort and learn all about life as a recruit to the Roman Army and the wider impact of Roman civilisation on life in Britain. Alongside the essential military skills of marching and basic drill, the recruits will make their own oil lamp and learn about Roman writing. They will learn how to find their way around a Roman fort, a little about Roman religion and how soldiers worked together on the battlefield to make the Roman army one of the most feared fighting units in history.

We will be leaving school at **8:30am**, therefore the children need to be at school for the earlier time of **8:15am** so that they can be registered and ready for a prompt departure. We will be returning to school for **3:45pm** depending on traffic. Regular updates will be shared on Dojo throughout the day.

All children should wear school uniform and suitable outdoor coats and shoes alongside a hat and sun-cream if the weather is going to be warm. If your child requires a travel sickness tablet, please make sure they have one before they come to school and put one in an envelope with their name on for the return journey. If your child needs a travel sickness tablet, a medical form must be completed and handed into the office before the visit. If your child uses an inhaler, please make sure they have one in school.

Your child will need a packed lunch on this day, if your child is entitled to free school meals this can be provided by school, please order via the following link <https://forms.office.com/e/G40gEzLsm7> . If your child would like to take part in the visit, please give consent via ParentPay.

The total cost for this visit is **£33.00 per child**, which is payable by ParentPay only, either online through the ParentPay website or at your local PayPoint. The payment was requested through a total of four instalments one in July 2023, October 2023, January 2024 and the final instalment on 31 May. For us to secure the event, it is important that we receive payment by **31 May 2024**.

While we fully appreciate that all contributions are voluntary, we are only able to offer experiences such as this if we receive sufficient support. If you are struggling to pay for the event, please come in and discuss this with us.
