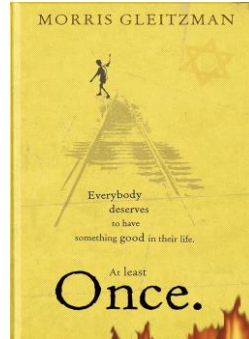


Welcome to the Summer 2 edition of the curriculum newsletter. You will find lots of information about your child's learning.
