You will be in a small group or 'bubble' with your friends.



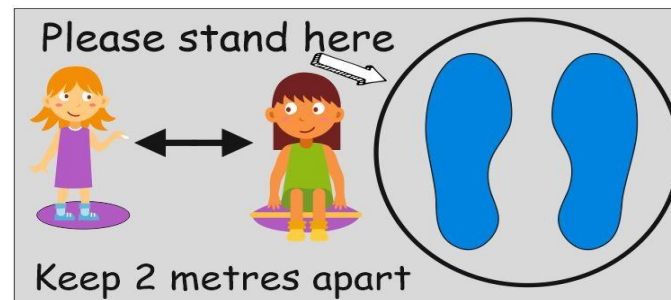
When you are in school you must remember to wash your hands. You will need to wash your hands whenever you go outside, or finish playing. Everybody is going to wash their hands a lot.

- As there is only one set of toilets for you all, we have labelled which toilet you can use during the day.



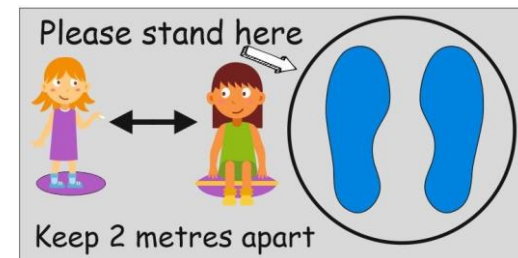
Lunchtime

- If you are in the Key Stage 1 hall, you will be given a packed lunch which will be a sandwich of your choice. This will be either cheese, tuna, ham, jam or chocolate spread.
- Year 6 can either bring their own packed lunch from home or have a school packed lunch.
- Your dinner ladies can't wait to see you all.



Keeping you Safe

- When you are in school it is important that you follow the rules your teacher tells you. This includes:-
 - Make sure I wash my hands or use hand sanitiser when I am asked to, particularly when I've been outside the classroom or when I cough or sneeze.
 - Make sure I don't play with children outside my bubble and try my best to keep two metres from all other children.
 - Only use my own pens and pencils and other personal equipment and only use the shared resources within in my group when I'm told to.
 - Make sure I don't bring anything in from home - If I do, I understand it will be put away by the teacher and given back at the end of the day.
 - Understand that if I deliberately don't follow the rules my parents will be spoken to.

There may be times when your teacher may need to wear special clothing to keep everyone safe. Do not be scared by this but we have to do this at the moment.
