Literacy

(Reading and Writing) We will be learning about five key concepts: print has meaning, different purposes, we read English text from left to right and from top to bottom, the names of the different parts of a book and page sequencing.

Maths

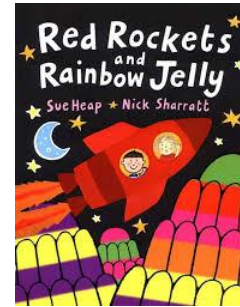
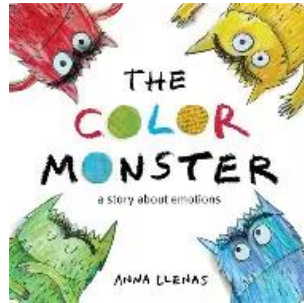
We will be making comparisons e.g. more than, fewer than and same. Exploring repeats in patterns, build with shapes and objects. As well as hear and say number names.

Understanding the world

We will be talking about families and developing positive attitudes about similarities and differences.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be developing our drawing skills and exploring colour mixing to create self-portraits.



Communication and Language Development

We will be listening to longer stories and remembering much of what happens. We will be using a wider range of vocabulary. We will understand and follow instructions that has two parts e.g. "Get your coat and wait at the door".

Physical Development

We will be developing our movement and balancing skills through physical activities such as riding bikes and climbing on the trim trail. We will develop fine motor skills through activities such as Dough Disco.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will become more outgoing with unfamiliar people, in the safe context of our setting. We will show more confidence in new social situations and will increasingly follow rules.

Helping your child at home

- Please write in your child's record each time you read with them. Children will bring home a 'Reading for pleasure' book to share with you.
- Help your child with independence e.g. dressing/undressing, going to the toilet independently, hand washing etc
- Talk about everything - their day at school, their favourite toys, food, anything!
