English

In English, we will develop poetry composition skills and descriptive writing in the form of a first-person narrative.

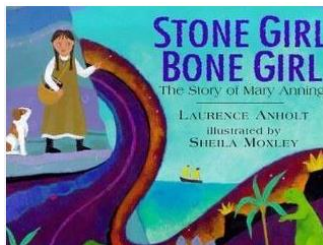
In Reading, we will be exploring a range of exciting texts linked to our Stone Age topic. These include stories, poems, and non-fiction, such as Stone Girl Bone Girl by Laurence Anholt, Stone Age Beasts By Ben Lerwill, The secrets of Stonehenge by Mick Manning and Stone Age Boy Satoshi Kitamura.

Maths

In Maths, we will cover place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division using White Rose units.

Science

In Science, we will explore plants, pollination and a plant's needs for survival. We will also investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.



History

In History, we will be learning about what Britain was like during the Stone Age.

Geography

In Geography, children will name and locate counties and cities of the United Kingdom, and use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about families and relationships, and how we care for and support one another.

RE

In RE, children will explore what makes us humans and spirituality.

Art

In Art, we will be developing our use of drawing and painting by exploring mark making using a range of tools and media.

DT

In DT, we will explore textiles focusing on stiffening and strengthening fabric for construction

PE

In PE, we will focus on football and basketball, developing skills and teamwork. PE days are **Wednesday and Friday**.

Music

In Music, we will explore ballads focusing on composition and performance

Computing

In Computing, we will learn programming, make simple programs and develop coding skills.
