Maltby Manor Academy Parent/Carer Governor Vacancy

I am writing to inform you that Maltby Manor Academy has a Parent/Carer Governor vacancy from 8 December 2025.

Joining the Academy Education Committee as a Parent/Carer Governor offers you the opportunity to make a real contribution to the life and work of Wath Academy. Governors play a key role in the strategic leadership of the Academy and raising of standards. Being a Governor can be very rewarding and will provide you with the opportunity to work as part of a team and gain new skills. Please note that a very important duty of any Governor is regularly to attend meetings and you should be sure that you are able to do this before applying. It is not essential that you have prior experience as training and support is provided.

The Academy Education Committee meetings are held seven times per year. Meetings are generally held on a Tuesday at 5.30pm and last for around 2 hours. Governors are also encouraged to make visits to the school and may attend school and Trust events as a representative of the Academy Education Committee. Please note that within the Maltby Learning Trust, we have a shared Governance model which means that Maltby Manor Academy shares members of the Academy Education Committee with Maltby Lilly Hall Academy. Within each of the 2-hour Academy Education Committee meetings, the business of both schools will be addressed. Parent Governors at Maltby Manor Academy automatically become Partnership Governors at Maltby Lilly Hall Academy.

We would ask therefore that, as part of the form, you write a brief personal statement regarding what you can offer the Academy Education Committee. This will be circulated to all Parents/Carers in the event of a ballot.

Please note that Maltby Learning Trust is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people therefore all Governors are required to undergo a DBS check before being appointed.
