English

In Writing, the children will be studying and composing third-person narratives, as well as learning how to write formal letters of complaint.

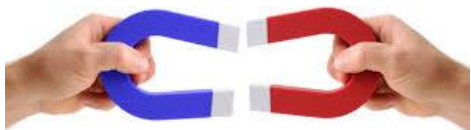
In reading, we will be reading various texts like Varjak Paw by S. F. Said, Great City by Harold Monro and Greta and the Giants.

Maths

In Maths, the children will begin by exploring the addition and subtraction of fractions, as well as finding fractions of an amount. As the half term progresses, they will then move on to learning about money and time.

Science

In Science, the children will be exploring the topic of forces and magnets. They will investigate how different forces act on objects, including pushes and pulls, and learn how magnets attract and repel. Through a range of practical investigations, the children will explore which materials are magnetic and discover how magnetic forces can act at a distance.



History

In History, the children will be learning about Ancient Egypt. They will explore when and where the Ancient Egyptian civilisation existed and discover what life was like during this fascinating period of history. The children will learn about the importance of the River Nile, the role of pharaohs, and the beliefs and traditions of the Ancient Egyptians, including their gods and mummification practices.

Geography

In Geography, the children will be developing their map and fieldwork skills. They will learn how to read and interpret Ordnance Survey (OS) maps, using symbols and keys to understand different features of a landscape. The children will also take part in fieldwork activities.

PSHE

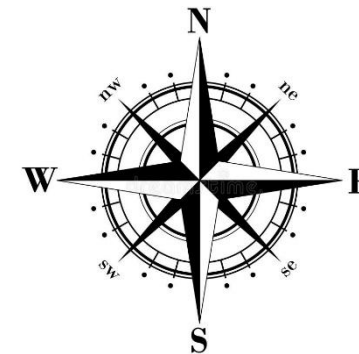
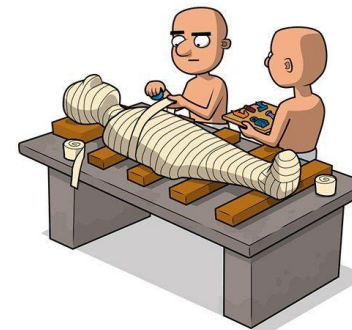
In PSHE, the children will continue learning about the rights of a child and what it means to be a responsible citizen. Later in the half term, the focus will move on to economic well-being.

RE

In RE, the children will explore why water is an important symbol in many religions.

Art

In Art, children will be exploring painting and a range of painting techniques.



DT

In DT, the children will be exploring systems and how they work.

PE

In PE, the children will focus on developing their athletic skills. They will take part in a range of activities designed to improve their coordination, teamwork and spatial awareness. PE days are **Monday and Wednesday**.

Music

In Music, the children will be exploring jazz. They will learn about the key features of this lively and expressive style of music, including rhythm, improvisation and call-and-response.

Computing

In Computing, we will learn programming, make simple programs and develop coding skills.
