

English

In English, we will be focusing on Spelling and Grammar on our approach to SATs. After that, we will be looking at different genres of writing where the children can apply their solid knowledge of grammatical features.

Reading

In reading, we will be looking at a lot of past SATs papers and focusing on a range of techniques to be successful, including adding depth of answers, retrieval and inference skills.

Maths

In Maths, we will cover a range of areas with focuses on reasoning and problem solving as we head towards SATs.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about **living things and habitats**, describing how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including microorganisms, plants and animals.
