Dear Parents/Carers

On **Wednesday 07 October 2026**, the Year Six children (current Y5 children) will be going to spend the day at Crucial Crew which is in the LifeWise centre on the Hellaby Industrial Estate. The day is led by the Crucial Crew staff and South Yorkshire Police and whilst there, our children experience vital life skills through a range of practical and scenario-based activities, which could arise in real life situations. Activities include internet safety, fire awareness, drug and alcohol awareness as well as taking part in a court room scenario. We have found that the children really benefit from the activities which they participate in.

To cover the cost of the transport, we request a voluntary contribution of **£5.75** and this needs to be paid please by **30 September 2026 via Parentpay**, along with **consent** for your child to attend. If we do not receive enough contributions, the visit will be unable to go ahead.

Whilst we appreciate that this is some time away, we wanted to give parents the maximum time possible to pay for the experience and give you plenty of notice of our upcoming trips.

Your child will need a packed lunch for this day (no sweets, fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). If your child accesses free school meals this packed lunch will be provided by school. The children will need a water bottle, waterproof coat, full school uniform and sensible school shoes. Inside the centre is cold, so please ensure your child has a coat with them.

We will be travelling by coach to and from school within the school day. If your child needs travel sickness tablets, please ensure they have one in the morning before they come to school and you complete a medication form from the office. Your child will not be administered any medication without a medical form.

Any child with an inhaler MUST have this on them at all times during the visit.

The information which you provide on ParentPay will be taken on the visit and used in case of an emergency.
