Dear Parent/Carer,

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that P.E. is a national requirement for children and all children need to have their P.E. kits in school on the days that they do P.E. We have specialised sports coaches who come into school to teach your children on a Monday or Thursday in addition to their class P.E. lessons with their teacher. We are wanting the children to engage in high quality lessons but this is not possible if they don't have the appropriate clothing.

Ideally P.E. kits should be brought into school on a Monday, kept in school for the whole week, and sent home on a Friday.

Your child will need the following in their PE kit:

- Outdoor trainers
- Black shorts or tracksuit bottoms
- Red PE top – this should be a different top to the one they wear as part of their uniform.

Could you please ensure that your child has the correct clothing for P.E.? In addition, for safety reasons, children are not permitted to wear jewellery of any kind when doing P.E. Earrings are a particular concern. If possible, they should be removed and left at home the days that your child has P.E. Unfortunately staff cannot remove earrings for children. Also, long hair needs to be tied back.
