RSE Parent Consultation

As a part of your child's education at Maltby Manor Academy, we aim to promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive citizenship curriculum. You might already know this as PHSE. This subject area gives young people the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives, meeting their full potential.

Our aim is to enable our pupils to grow into successful 'Maltby Citizens' by providing them with a curriculum of excellence, allowing them to excel in the world beyond the school gates. Our curriculum is underpinned by the 5 pillars of wellbeing: Career, Social, Financial, Physical and Community.

The RHSE National Programme of study, which all schools are expected to comply with was updated from Summer Term 2021. You will recall that we consulted at this time about the curriculum.
