The ingredients of which are listed below.

Fortified Wheat Flour [Wheat Flour, Calcium Carbonate, Iron, Niacin (B3), Thiamin (B1)], Water, Mixed Fruits (17%) [Raisins, Sultanas], Orange Soaked Sultanas (4%) [Sultanas, Orange Juice from Concentrate], Invert Sugar Syrup, Wheat Protein, Yeast, Candied Mixed Peel (2%) [Orange Peel, Glucose-Fructose Syrup, Sugar, Lemon Peel, Acidity Regulator (Citric Acid)], Vegetable Oils and Fat [Rapeseed Oil, Palm Fat, Palm Oil], Emulsifiers (Mono- and Diglycerides of Fatty Acids, Mono- and Diacetyl Tartaric Acid Esters of Mono- and Diglycerides of Fatty Acids), Salt, Soya Flour, Maize Starch, Flavouring, Flour Treatment Agent (Ascorbic Acid)
