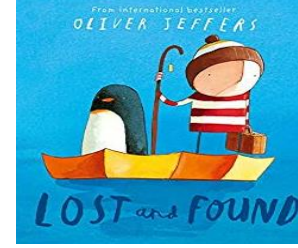


CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER

This half term we would like you to complete the following learning projects at home:

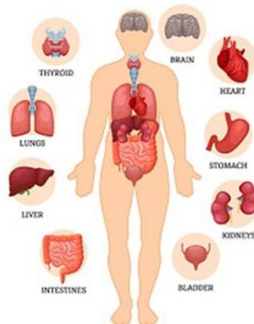
Can you make a Victorian doll using either a wooden peg or a wooden spoon?
